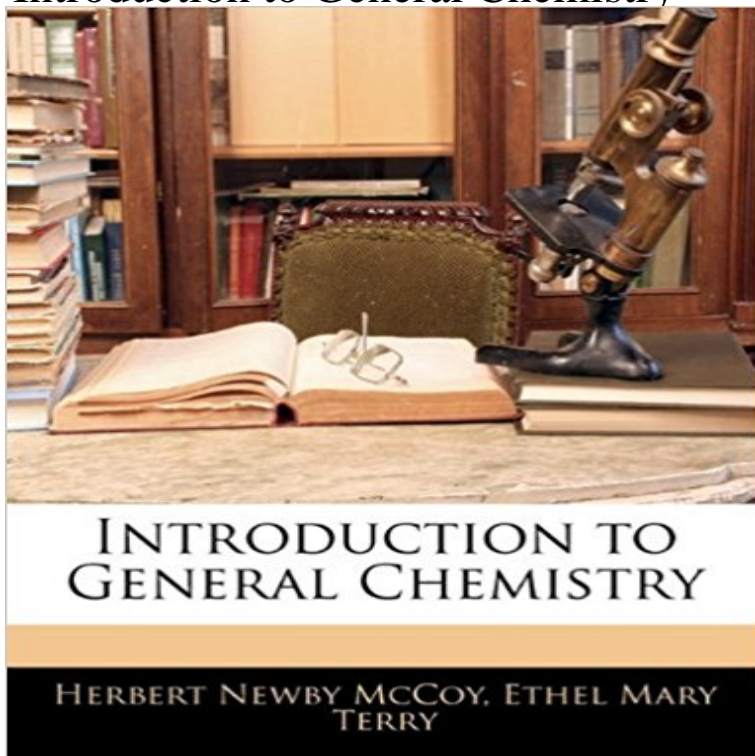


Introduction to General Chemistry
